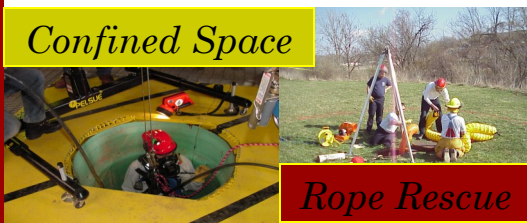

Who We Are

The Northern Kentucky Technical Rescue Team is a regional team trained and equipped to respond to specialty rescue incidents that fall outside the scope of standard fire and EMS responsibilities. In the event of an emergency the TRT will respond to any incident in the Greater Cincinnati Area or KY EMA region 7 area.

Team Training

Members have been formally trained to meet the unique challenges that specialty rescue presents.

Members continue their training on a monthly basis with lecture and hands-on skills sessions, establishing proficiency in each area of specialized training. Monthly training sessions are open to area Fire/EMS organizations. All training meets or exceeds the minimum requirements for OSHA and NFPA standards.

Dispatch Procedures

If an emergency response is required, the team must be requested through local dispatch by calling 911. The Incident Commander on scene should direct their dispatch center to contact Boone County Communications Center at (859) 371-1234 to request the TRT to respond. Once the TRT is dispatched they will contact the requesting agency for further information on the nature of the incident.

Regional Approach

Originally formed in 1995 as a cooperating agreement between three fire departments, the team now accepts members throughout the Northern Kentucky. Our team is dedicated to representing, supporting and responding anywhere in Northern Kentucky as a truly regional entity.



Innovation in Cooperation

A large part of the success of the TRT has been due to the alliance between TRT and SD #1. This alliance incorporates more dedicated, qualified professionals, and a greater diversity of equipment. The result is a unified team with a greater response capability.



Now, this innovation has entered a new phase. TRT has partnered with the Northern Kentucky Horse Network. This agreement ensures that the team has the personnel and equipment necessary to provide large animal rescue capabilities.
